

Summary of Pupil Premium Payments

Academic Year 2012-2013

Heathfield has 44.66 pupils who receive free school meals based on January 2013 census eligible in last 6 years, we receive £33,251 in pupil premium for these pupils.

Heathfield has 4.6 pupils who are in care and we receive £1,999 in pupil premium for these pupils.

Heathfield has 6.7 pupils based on January 2013 from service families, we receive £2,145 in pupil premium for these pupils.

Total= £37,395

The analysis of whole school data and data pertaining to vulnerable groupings does not indicate any patterns or areas of concern for these three groups of pupils. We have therefore used the Pupil Premium to enhance the other than educational needs for these pupils. All of these pupils have access to: the play room and the therapist (highlighted as an outstanding provision in Ofsted 2012) the art room and therapist (highlighted as an outstanding provision in Ofsted 2012). We have a specialist sensory occupational therapist to support the sensory needs of these pupils. We also offer Girls club, Boys club and lunch time clubs, Elsa, draw and talk, Speech and language enhanced provision, pastoral support, play and learn and toileting support. We have also introduced a 1.1 behaviour support worker to be available to any of these pupils as the need arises.

Ofsted Stated that the Spiritual, moral, social and cultural aspects of the school were outstanding. We believe that our ethos has been enhanced by the provisions mentioned above.

We remain committed to annually reviewing our use of Pupil premium in light of the data trends and needs of the pupils.
